

The Mighty One of Jacob

Intro:

1. Consider Jacob's blessing upon Joseph — Gen. 49:24.

Body:

- I. The Mighty one of Jacob would bring the Messiah — Ps. 132.
 - A. David had made a vow — Ps. 132:2-5; 2 Sam. 7:1-3.
 - B. The Mighty One of Jacob in turn made an oath —
Ps. 132:11; 2 Sam. 7:12-13.
 - C. Jesus was sent as a son of David (Matt. 1:1; Matt. 9:27; Matt. 15:22; Matt. 20:30; Matt. 21:9).
 1. He sat upon the spiritual throne of David — Acts 2:30-33.
- II. The Mighty One of Jacob would purge and restore Jerusalem —
Isa. 1.
 - A. In the days of Isaiah, Jerusalem had become corrupt —
Isa 1:21-23.
 - B. The Mighty One of Jacob promised to redeem Zion —
Isa. 1:24-27.
 - C. That promise has been fulfilled — Gal. 4:26; Heb. 12:22-23.
- III. The Mighty One of Jacob makes wrongs right — Isa. 49:24-26.
 - A. The Mighty One of Jacob was able to make wrongs right —
Isa. 49:24-26.
 1. He is strong and capable of avenging the righteous —
Eccl. 5:8; Rom. 12:19.
 - B. We should not be concerned with the injustices of this life.
 1. For the time will come... — Phil.2:9-11.
- IV. The Mighty One of Jacob will usher in a glorified Zion —
Isa. 60:11, 15-22.
 - A. Compare this to — Rev. 21: 1-5, 18-19, 23, 25.
 - B. The Mighty One of Jacob will fulfill His promise —
Tt. 1:2; Jn. 14:1-3.

1. Jehovah is the Mighty One of us all.
 - a. He is mighty to fulfill His promises —
1 Cor. 10:13; Rom. 8:28; Heb. 7:25.
